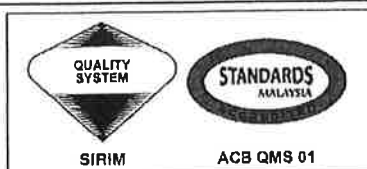
CLARIFICATION ON CODING FOR ENDOVENOUS LASER ABLATION

We refer to the above matter and your letter dated 18th March 2025 regarding the appropriate procedure fee for endovenous laser ablation performed for a patient diagnosed with right lower limb venous insufficiency.

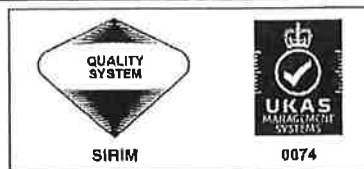
2. Based on discussions with the Vascular Society of Malaysia, appropriate benchmarking and taking into consideration the complexity and technique involved, Ministry of Health Malaysia had issued a letter KKM.87/A9/7/34 Jld 4(48) dated 16th April 2021 with the following recommendation:

Endovenous therapy of one or more incompetent vein(s) / truncal vein(s) using percutaneous method with image guidance in a single lower limb by any method (e.g. thermal, mechanical, pharmacological)	RM 2,390	RM 985
