

EXISTING PRACTITIONER (SECTION 46)

Registration & PC Requirements:

- Proof of identifications
 - ► National Registration Identification Card (NRIC)
 - Recent Photograph (Passport Size)
- Professional qualifications
 - Diploma with certain years of experience / Degree
 - ▶ Transcripts
- Proof that you have been practising in the profession
 - ► Employer verification- HR/Manager/Supervisor
 - Additional requirements as prescribed by Council
 - * Independent Service Provider: 2 Persons that can verify your professional practises
- Statutory Declaration
- Transitional Provision : 12 months or any other period as may be extended by the council

NEW ENTRANTS (SECTION 16)

- Proof of identification:
 - ► National Registration Identification Card (NRIC)
 - ► Recent Photograph (Passport Size)
- Professional qualifications:
 - Degree (minimum)
 - ▶ Transcripts
- Statutory Declaration
- Pre-requisite Requirements (Section 16c)

PRACTISING CERTIFICATE (SECTION 22)

Proof of Professional Employment

- ▶ By Employer /HR / Manager/ Supervisor
- ► Independent Service Provider: : SSM Registration, Registered Office, Referees : 2 Registered Practitioner that can verify your professional practises
- Validity of PC: 2 year



TEMPORARY PRACTISING CERTIFICATE (NON - MALAYSIAN CITIZEN) (SECTION 24)

Requirements:

- Proof of identifications
 - Passport
 - Recent Photograph (Passport Size)
- Professional qualifications
 - Degree (minimum)
 - Transcripts
- Proof that you have been practising in the profession for required period
 - Letter of good standing from Regulatory Body in Practising Country
 - Work Experience
 - Recent Medical Report on applicant's health status issued by a registered medical practitioner
 - Offer letter and details of employment in Malaysia
- Statutory Declaration
- Validity of TPC : 1 year
- Renewal: Compulsory CPD point
